

In addition to the beautiful golf course, guests here have access to the hotel's Tennis and Aquatics Centre, which boasts three beautiful pools; there's also a fully equipped fitness center, nature trails, winery, and fun games like archery and croquet. Also be sure to visit the grand hotel's library, sitting rooms, and parlors, which are perfect for cozying up with your sweetheart.

Keswick's spa is also sure to help set a nice romantic mood for your getaway. 























The Hermitage Hotel


