Explore tidal marsh areas by kayak or paddle board, or man-up and charter a day boat for a full-on ocean experience. Make your first stop SouthEast Adventure Outfitters (www. southeastadventure.com) where the crew will hook you up with rentals or even arrange for overnight excursions.

Golfers need look no further than the K&P's renowned resort course. *Golf Georgia* called this Joe Lee designed track a "truly indigenous masterpiece." An interior grouping of four marsh framed






# WHERE TO EAT
